Inspect transmission fluid level and filter (if truck is >450,000 miles and fluid/filter hasn't been change, change fluid and filter)	Inspect ABS wiring and routing
	Check for proper suspension ride height
Inspect transmission and differential yokes for play	Inspect PTO operation (if applicable)
Check rear-end fluid levels and check for metal and water contamination in rear-end fluids	Check hydraulic fluid level (if applicable)
	Inspect wet-line hoses and routing (if applicable)
Change oil and oil/fuel filters (if not done in the last 10,000 miles)	Check coolant level, freeze point, DCA level, and for fuel or oil contamination
☐ Change DEF filter (if not done in last 100,000 miles)	☐ Inspect radiator and shroud
Lube chassis and driveline	☐ Inspect all hoses
Check steer hub fluid levels	☐ Inspect A/C compressor/clutch operation
☐ Inspect tie rod ends	☐ Check A/C temp at vents
☐ Inspect drag link	☐ Inspect CAC
☐ Inspect pitman arm	Check operation of air dryer
Check power steering fluid level	Check air system governor pressure
Check power steering system for leaks	Check operation of air tank drain valves

Check power window and lock operation (if applicable)	UNDER VEHICLE
Inspect seat belts	☐ Inspect for transmission leaks
☐ Inspect bunk restraints	☐ Inspect for differential leaks
☐ Inspect dash panel	☐ Inspect for air leaks outside of truck
☐ Inspect operation of all gauges	☐ Check for wheel seal leaks
☐ Inspect operation of all switches	☐ Check for engine oil leaks
Check operation of 12 volt power sockets	☐ Check for coolant leaks
Check stereo and CB operation (if applicable)	☐ Inspect engine and transmission mounts
☐ Inspect mirror (heat and power) operation	☐ Inspect air cleaner housing and element condition
Check operation of all interior lights	Check air-to-air piping and clamps
☐ Inspect door hinges and latches	Check for oil in air-to-air pipe at turbo/excessive play
☐ Inspect compartment door and cabinet operation	☐ Inspect belt alignment, condition, and adjustment
☐ Verify all locks work with keys	☐ Inspect starter operation
☐ Inspect horns (city and air) operation	Check charging system and record voltage
☐ Inspect DID functions and read outs	☐ Load test batteries
☐ Inspect for air leaks in cab	☐ Inspect engine wiring for rubs or abrasions
Inspect sleeper curtain and track operation	☐ Inspect fan hub and fan blade
Check heater operation, all levels	Check engine fan operation
Replace mattress	☐ Inspect EATS components for visible damage/leaks
☐ Clean carpets	Perform snap acceleration test to verify no black smoke
Detail interior of cab and sleeper	from exhaust

☐ Inspect condition of cab	☐ Make DOT passable
☐ Inspect sleeper air-ride system	Download ECM totals
☐ Inspect paint condition	☐ Verift that any passwords have been removed
☐ Inspect condition of mirrors and mountings	☐ Check, record, and repair/clear any active fault codes
☐ Inspect cab steps	☐ Check software version, upgrade to latest if needed
Check aiming of headlights	Perform Exhaust Aftertreatment System regeneration
Check trailer light cord with tester	test/operation
Inspect trailer air lines and glad hands	Check soot level (if Ash or Soot Load Percent is >130% perform preventative maintenance filter cleaning)
Complete truck degrease including engine	Check warranty history and take action if any open
Wash exterior of truck	issues are found
Polish exterior of truck	☐ Check for open campaigns/recalls
